2024 was a transformative year for RIG Scorrier, marking our journey from a construction project to a fully operational facility. Here's an overview of the key milestones achieved:

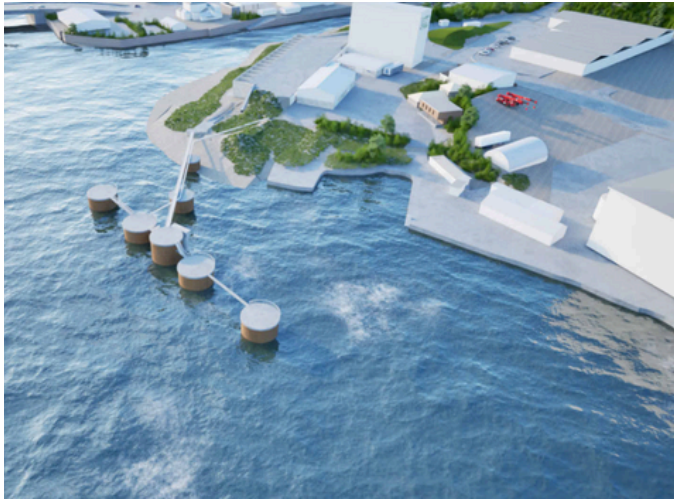
